**RESOLVED:** that the following works are approved - to dig back and overlay rubber Tigermulch to areas worn through, pulled apart and showing exposed concrete under all equipment plus 3 no. 600 x 600 slabs laid in front of bench – at a cost of £3,485.00 + VAT.
